OF INDIA.

No. GHM/2014/ 5 /SSP/152010/884664/A :- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Assistant Teacher (other than Assistant Teacher for Special or Technical or both subjects), Class III, in Higher Secondary Section of the Government Ideal Residential School for Developing Caste, in the subordinate service of the Directorate of Developing Caste welfare, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Assistant Teacher (other than Assistant Teacher for Special or Technical or both subjects), Class III, in Higher Secondary Section of the Government Ideal Residential School for Developing Caste, Recruitment Rules, 2014.
2. Appointment to the post of Assistant Teacher (other than Assistant Teacher for Special or Technical or both subjects), Class III in Higher Secondary Section of the Government Ideal Residential School for Developing Caste, in the subordinate service of the Directorate of Developing Caste, shall be made either,—
 - (a) by temporary transfer on deputation basis of teacher (other than Assistant Teacher for special or technical or both subjects) of the Government Higher Secondary Schools or Higher Secondary Schools under the Education Department; or
 - (b) by direct selection.
3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,—
 - (a) not be more than 34 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

(b) possess-

- (i) a master's degree in Arts or Science or Commerce obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act 1956;
- (ii) a bachelor's degree in Education obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be a deemed University under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act 1956;
- (iii) have passed "Teachers Aptitude Test (TAT)" conducted by the Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board, Gandhinagar with at least 50 percent marks:

Provided that the marks secured by the candidate in Teachers Aptitude Test shall be valid for five years from the date of the result of the Teachers Aptitude Test.

- (iv) the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;
 - (v) adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
4. The selection of candidate shall be made on the basis of a select list which shall be prepared on the basis of marks secured by the candidates in Teachers Aptitude Test and other educational qualifications prescribed in clauses (i) and (ii) of sub rule (b) of rule 3 for direct selection. Teachers Aptitude Test shall be given a weightage of 70 percent and 30 percent weightage shall be given to the other prescribed educational qualifications as mentioned below.



6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to pass the examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to undergo such training and pass such

examination in accordance with the rules as may be prescribed by the Government.

9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.

No. GHM/2014/ 6 /SSP/152010/884664/A:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Assistant Teacher (other than Assistant Teacher for Special or Technical or both subjects), Class III, in Secondary Section of the Government Ideal Residential School for Developing Caste, in the subordinate service of the Directorate of Developing Caste welfare, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Assistant Teacher (other than Assistant Teacher for Special or Technical or both subjects), Class III, in Secondary Section of the Government Ideal Residential School for Developing Caste Recruitment Rules, 2014.
2. Appointment to the post of Assistant Teacher for (other than Assistant Teacher Special or Technical or both subjects), Class III in Secondary Section of the Government Ideal Residential School for Developing Caste, in the subordinate service of the Directorate of Developing Caste shall be made either, —
 - (a) by temporary transfer on deputation basis of teacher (other than Assistant Teacher for special or technical or both subjects) of the Government Secondary Schools or Secondary Schools under the Education Department; or
 - (b) by direct selection.
3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall-
 - (a) not be more than 32 years of age:
Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the Service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967,
 - (b) possess, —

- (i) a bachelor's degree in Arts or Science or Commerce obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956;
- (ii) a bachelor's degree in Education obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956;
- (iii) have passed "Teachers Aptitude Test (TAT)" conducted by the Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board, Gandhinagar with at least 50 percent marks:

Provided that the marks secured by the candidate in Teachers Aptitude Test shall be valid for five years from the date of the result of the Teachers Aptitude Test.

- (iv) the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;
 - (v) adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
4. The selection of candidate shall be made on the basis of a select list which shall be prepared on the basis of marks secured by the candidates in Teachers Aptitude Test and other educational qualifications prescribed in clauses (i) and (ii) of sub rule (b) of rule 3 for direct selection. Teachers Aptitude Test shall be given a weightage of 70 percent and 30 percent weightage shall be given to the other prescribed educational qualifications as mentioned below:

6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to pass the examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
8. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to undergo such training and pass such examination in accordance with the rules as may be prescribed by the Government.

9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
