- 1. These rules may be called the Assistant Teacher (Secondary) Class III, (other than Assistant Teacher for Special or Technical or both subjects) Recruitment Rules, 2009.
- 2. Appointment to the post of Assistant Teacher (Secondary) Class III, [(other than Assistant Teacher for special or Technical or both subjects) in secondary section at Ideal Residential school for scheduled castes in the subordinate service of the

Directorate of Scheduled Castes Welfare] shall be made either: -

- (a) by direct selection; or
- (b) by temporary transfer on deputation basis from amongst the persons working on the cadre of Assistant Teacher (Secondary) Class III, in secondary section under the various departments of the State.
- 3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall-
- (a) not be more than 30 years of age;
- (b) possess (i) a bachelor's degree with second class in the relevant subjects for the relevant post of obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognized as such or declared to be deemed as University under section 3 of the University grants Commission Act, 1956; or possess an equivalent qualification recognized by the Government; and
 - (ii) a Bachelor's degree in Education obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as University under testing I white

possess an equivalent qualification recognised by the Government;

Explanation: Relevant subject for the relevant post means i.e. for the post of Teacher in Mathematics subject, the concerned candidate shall possess a degree with Mathematics.

- (c) possess the basic knowledge of computer application in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;
- (d) possess the adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classicisation and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

- 4. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of one year.
- 5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, be required to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.

6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.

7. A candidate appointed by direct selection will be required to pass the Departmental Examination in accordance with the rules as may be prescribed by the Government.

8. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall have to undergo such Training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.

9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a surety and security bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government in that behalf.

- (a) by temporary transfer on deputation basis of teacher (other than Assistant Teacher for Special or Technical or both subjects) of the Government Secondary Schools or Secondary Schools under the Education Department; or
- (b) by direct selection.
- 3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,
- (a) not be more than 37 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

Provided Further that nothing contained in clause (b) of sub -rule 8 of the Gujarat Civil Service Classification and Recruitment (Genral) Rule, 1967

shall be applicable in so far as relaxation of upper age limit as prescribed above is concerned.

(b) possess:-

- (i) a bachelor's degree in Arts or Science or Commerce obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; and
- (ii) a bachelor's degree in Education obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956;
- (c) have passed the Teachers Aptitude Test (TAT) conducted by the Gujarat Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Board, Gandhinagar with at least 50 percent. marks:

Provided that the marks secured by the candidate in the Teachers Aptitude Test shall be valid for five years from the date of the result of the Teachers Aptitude Test.

- (d) Possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;
- (e) Possess the adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
- 4. The selection of candidate shall be made on the basis of a select list which shall be prepared on the basis of marks secured by the candidates in the Teachers Aptitude Test and other educational qualifications prescribed in clauses (i) and (ii) of sub rule (b) of rule 3 for direct selection. The Teachers Aptitude Test shall be given a weightage of 70 percent. and 30 percent. weightage shall be given to the other prescribed educational qualifications as mentioned below:
