No: GH/SH/4/2010/MKM/102007/842/J:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Principal, Class-II, in the Ideal Residential Schools for Scheduled Castes (Secondary and Higher Secondary Sections) under the Directorate of Scheduled Caste Welfare, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Principal, Class-II, Recruitment Rules, 2010.
2. Appointment to the post of Principal, Class-II, in the Ideal Residential Schools for Scheduled Castes (Secondary and Higher Secondary Sections) under the Directorate of Scheduled Caste Welfare, shall be made either :-

(A) by **promotion** of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who,-

(a)(i) have worked for not less than seven years in the cadre of (i) Assistant Teacher (Secondary) or (ii) Drawing Teacher (Special subject) or (iii) Physical Education Teacher,

or

(ii) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Assistant Teacher (Higher Secondary); and

(b) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provision of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules 2006;

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in clauses (a) or (b) above is not available for

promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up a post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period, it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two thirds of the period, specified in clauses (a)(i) or (a)(ii) above; or

(B) by direct selection, or

(C) by temporary transfer on deputation basis from amongst the persons working in the cadre of Principal and who possess the educational qualifications and/or experience prescribed in clause (b) and/or (c) of rule 4 for direct selection.

3. (a) The appointment by promotion and direct selection under the sub-rule (A) and (B) of rule 2 shall be made in the ratio of 5:1;

(b) The appointment by promotion from the cadres specified in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) of clause (a) of sub-rule (A) of rule 2 shall be made in the ratio of 4:1 respectively.

4. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,-

(a) not be more than 37 years of age;

(b) possess a second class Master degree in any subject and a second class master degree in education obtained from any of the Universities or institutions established or incorporated by or under a Central or State Act in India; or any institution recognised as such or declared as deemed university under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 or an equivalent qualification recognised by the Government;

(c) have five years of experience of teaching, or inspection in Education field or administration in Education Institute recognised by the Government after obtaining the academic qualification specified in clause (b) above;

(d) posses the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

(e) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati and/or Hindi;

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules 1967;

5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.
6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall during his probation period be required to pass the qualifying examination for Computer knowledge in accordance with the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
7. A candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall, have to undergo such training and to pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
8. The selected candidate shall be required to pass the departmental examination and examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government from time to time.
9. The selected candidate shall be required to furnish a surety and security bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time

No:GH/SH/15/2017/MKM/102007/842/J:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article-309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of **Principal, Class II** in the Ideal Residential Schools for Scheduled Castes (Secondary and Higher Secondary Sections) under the Directorate of Scheduled Castes Welfare, Gujarat State, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Principal, Class II, in the Ideal Residential Schools for Scheduled Castes (Secondary and Higher Secondary Sections) under the Directorate of Scheduled Castes Welfare, Recruitment Rules 2017.
2. Appointment to the post of Principal, Class II, in the Ideal Residential Schools for Scheduled Castes (Secondary and Higher Secondary Sections) under the Directorate of Scheduled Castes Welfare, shall be made either, -
 - (a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who,-
 - (i) have worked for not less than seven years in the cadre of Assistant Teacher (Secondary) or Drawing Teacher (Special subject) or Physical Education Teacher, or
 - (ii) have worked for not less than seven years in the cadre of Assistant Teacher (Higher Secondary);
 - (iii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules 2006.

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person

having experience for a lesser period, it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) above; or,

(b) by direct selection; or

(c) by temporary transfer on deputation basis from amongst the persons working in the cadre of Principal and who possess the educational qualifications or experience or both prescribed in clauses (b) and (c) of rule 4.

3. (a) The appointment by promotion and by direct selection under the sub-clauses (a) and (b) of rule 2 shall be made in the ratio of 5:1 respectively.

(b) The appointment by promotion from the cadres specified in sub-clauses (i) and (ii) of clause (a) of rule 2 shall be made in the ratio of 1:2 respectively.

4. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the posts mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall,-

(a) not be more than 44 years of age;

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favor of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967.

Provided further that nothing contained in clause (b) of sub-rule (9) of rule 8 of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in so far as relaxation of upper age limit as prescribed above is concerned.

(b) Possess,-

(i) a post graduate degree with atleast 55% of the marks or its equivalent grade B in the seven point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E and F at the master degree level obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such by the Government or declared to be a deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956.

(ii) a bachelor degree in education with atleast 60% of the marks or its equivalent grade B in the seven point scale

with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E and F from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such by the Government or declared to be a deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956.

Explanation


Where the University or college or Institution declares results in grade point, which is on a scale of seven point. The following mechanism shall be referred to ascertain equivalent marks in percentage.

Grade	Grade point	Percentage equivalent
“ O ” Outstanding	5.50 – 6.00	75 – 100
“ A ” Very good	4.50 – 5.49	65 - 74
“ B ” Good	3.50 – 4.49	55 - 64
“ C ” Average	2.50 – 3.49	45 – 54
“ D ” Below Average	1.50 – 2.49	35 – 44
“ E ” Poor	0.50 – 1.49	25 - 34
“ F ” Fail	00 – 0.49	00- 24

- (c) have about five years combined or separate experience of teaching or inspecting educational institution or administration in educational institution recognised by the Government after obtaining the academic qualification specified in clause (b) above.
 - (d) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules 1967;
 - (e) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both:
5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.
 6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, be required to undergo pre-service training and to pass the post training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gazetted Officer's (Pre-Service Training and Examination) Rules, 1970.

7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall, during his probation period, be required to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
8. The candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall be required to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
9. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to pass the departmental examination and an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
10. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a surety and security bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
