RESOLUTION :-

Government has accepted in ^{toto} / all the recommendations of the Socially and Educationally Backward Class Commission popularly known as Bakshi Commission. Government has also decided to grant certain benefits/concessions to the Economically Backward Classes. In order to decide whether a person belongs to any one of the 82 Castes/Classes/Groups recommended by the Socially and Educationally Backward Class Commission and also whether the person belongs to the Economically Backward Class, Government has decided to empower the following authorities to issue certificates in the forms prescribed for these purposes :-

I. Authorities competent to issue certificates in respect of 82 Castes/Classes/Groups recommended by the Socially and Educationally Backward Class Commission :

- (1) Collector,
- (2) District Development Officer,
- (3) Assistant Collector/Deputy Collector,
- (4) Deputy District Development Officer,
- (5) Mamlatdar,
- (6) Taluka Development Officer,
- (7) Mahalkari,
- (8) District Social Welfare Officer.

II. Authorities competent to issue certificates
in respect of Economically Backward Classes :-

- (1) Collector,
- (2) District Development Officer,
- (3) Assistant Collector/Deputy Collector,
- (4) Deputy District Development Officer,
- (5) Mamlatdar,
- (6) Taluka Development Officer.
- (7) Mahalkari.

2. Matriculation or School Leaving Certificate or birth certificate giving the caste or community of the candidate and place of residence should also be accepted for this purpose.
