CONSTITUTION
OF INDIA

No. GH/L/5/MKM-102002-967-J:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules, to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Deputy Director of Scheduled Caste Welfare, Class-I, District Backward Class Welfare Officer, Class-I and Vigilance Officer Class-I in the Gujarat Social Welfare Service, under the Directorate of Scheduled Castes Welfare, Gujarat State, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Deputy Director of Scheduled Caste Welfare, District Backward Class Welfare Officer and Vigilance Officer, Class-I, Recruitment Rules, 2007.
2. Appointment to the post of Deputy Director of Scheduled Caste Welfare, District Backward Class Welfare Officer and Vigilance Officer, in the Directorate of Scheduled Castes Welfare shall be made either

(a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons who -

(i) have worked for not less than eight years in the cadre of Social Welfare Officer, House Master of Government Backward Class Hostel for Boys, Lady Superintendent of Government Backward Class Hostel for Girls, Training Officer of Pre-service Training Centres, Kendra Sanchalaks of Prayog Kendras, in Gujarat Social Welfare Service Class II, and

(ii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up a post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period, it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period of not less than two-thirds of the period specified in sub-clause (i) above; or

(b) by direct selection.

3. The appointments by direct selection and by promotion shall be made in the ratio of 1:2 respectively.

4. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the posts mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall

(a) not be more than thirty three years of age;

(b) possess

(i) a second class Bachelor's Degree and a Diploma in Social Work, Social Welfare or Social Service Administration obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under Central or State Act in India; or any other educational Institution established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as University under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or possess

an equivalent qualification recognized as such by the Government for this purpose:

Or

- (ii) a second class post graduate degree in Social Welfare obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under Central or State Act in India; or any other educational institution established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as University under Section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or possess an equivalent qualification recognized as such by the Government for this purpose:
- (c) have experience of three years in social work after obtaining the prescribed educational qualifications;
- (d) Possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules 1967;
- (e) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati and/or Hindi:

Provided that preference may be given to candidate who possesses higher educational qualifications or not less than two years administrative experience in the capacity of Gazetted Officer, Class II or above in the Central Government Services or the State Government Services or the Panchayat Services:

Provided further that the upper age limit may also be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules 1967.

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5. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of two years.
6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to undergo pre-service training and pass the post training examination during his probation period in accordance with the Gazetted Officers (Pre service Training and Examination) Rules 1970.
7. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall during his probation period be require to pass the qualifying examination for Computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
8. The selected candidate shall require to pass the departmental examination, and an examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both in accordance with the rules prescribed in that behalf by the Government from time to time.
9. The candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall have to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.
10. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish a surety and security bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government from time to time.
