Sachivalaya, Gandhinagar, 18th June, 2016.**CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.**

No.GH/SH/20/2016/MKM/10/2014/697889/CHH :- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the **post of Office Superintendent, Class III**, in the subordinate service of the Directorate of Social Defence, Gujarat State, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Office Superintendent, Class III, in the Directorate of Social Defence, Recruitment Rules, 2016.

2. Appointment to the post of Office Superintendent, Class III, in the subordinate service of the Directorate of Social Defence, Gujarat State, shall be made either,-

a) by promotion of a person of proved merit and efficiency from amongst the persons, who,-

(i) have worked for not less than five years in the cadre of Head Clerk, Class III in the subordinate service of the Directorate of Social Defence, Gujarat State;

(ii) have passed the prescribed departmental examination in accordance with the Gujarat Social Defence Department -(conditions of service relating to the sub-service Departmental and Higher Departmental Examinations) Rules, 1972; and

(iii) have passed the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006:

Provided that where the appointing authority is satisfied that a person having the experience specified in sub-clause (i) above is not available for promotion and that it is necessary in the public interest to fill up the post by promotion even of a person having experience for a lesser period; it may, for reasons to be recorded in writing, promote such person who possesses experience of a period or not less than two-thirds of the period, specified in sub-clause (i) above; or

(b) by direct selection.

3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall, -

(a) not be more than 35 years of age:

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

(b) Possess,-

(i) a bachelor's degree obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the **Central or State Act** in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a

University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or possess an equivalent qualification recognised by the Government;

- (ii) the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;
 - (iii) adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
4. The provisions of rule 9A of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967 shall be applicable in respect of a candidate appointed by direct selection.
 5. The candidate appointed either by direct selection or by promotion shall require to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
 6. The candidate appointed by direct selection shall require to furnish a security and surety bond in such form, for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
