- Be associated with any Child Care Institution, directly or indirectly, during his tenure as the Chairperson or member of the Committee or have any other conflict of interest;
- (v) Be affiliated to any political party; or
- (vi) Be insolvent
- (vii) Has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude, and such conviction has not been reversed or has not been granted full pardon in respect of such offence;
