Subject :- Recruitment Rules for Compounders  
in the Medical Department  
Amendment of -

Letter No.228/E, dated 3-9-56 from the Surgeon General with the Government of Bombay.

RESOLUTION:- Government is pleased to direct that the existing Rule 71-D in the Bombay Civil Services Classification and Recruitment Rules should be substituted by the following :-

Compounders in the Medical Department.

71-D Appointment shall be made by nomination from amongst candidates who

- (1) have passed the S.S.C. or any other equivalent examination.
- (2) are not more than 25 years of age at the time of appointment;
- (3) have passed
  - (a) the prescribed compounders examination of
  - (b) the examination of practicing Pharmacists training Courses conducted by the Indian Pharmaceutical Association (Bombay State Branch) or
  - (c) hold diploma University and
- (4) have registered their names with the Bombay State Pharmacy Council.

2. The political and Services Department is requested to issue necessary correction slip to the Bombay Civil Services Classification and Recruitment Rules.
