No. GH/ /MKM/1091/978/CHH : In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Compositor, Class-III in the subordinate service under the Directorate of Social Defence namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Compositor Recruitment Rules, 1996.
2. Appointment to the post of Compositor Class-III in the subordinate service under the Directorate of Social Defence shall be made either
 - (a) by direct selection; or
 - (b) by transfer from amongst the persons working in the cadre of Compositor in the office of the Director of Printing and Stationary Department.
3. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection to the post mentioned in rule 2, a candidate shall
 - (a) not be more than 30 years of age.
 - (b) have passed the Secondary School Certificate Examination or its equivalent examination.
 - (c) have passed the trade test consisting of four hours in Hand Composing in English, Gujarati and Hindi.
 - (d) have ability to compose 1000 corrected Ems per hour in English and 800 corrected Ems per hour in Gujarati both excluding distribution;
 - (e) have knowledge of different type styles, display and tabular Composition make up imposition;
 - (f) be able to carry out about 80 corrections per hour and

(g) possess experience of compositor for a period of about five years ;


Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favour of a candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of Gujarat Civil Service Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967, as amended from time to time.

4. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be on probation for a period of one year.

5. The selected candidate shall be required to pass an examination in Gujarati or Hindi or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government from time to time.

6. A candidate appointed by direct selection shall be required to furnish security and surety bonds in such form and for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
