1. Appointment to the post shall be made by direct selection.

2. To be eligible for appointment by direct selection candidate must :—

(a) be not less than 23 years and not more than 30 years of age,

Provided that the age limit will be relaxed upto 35 years for persons in the following categories already in the service of Government of Gujarat.

(i) those in subordinate service of the Social Welfare Department :

(ii) those serving in the subordinate service of the other departments of the State Government.

Provided further that the age limit may be relaxed in favour of candidates possessing exceptionally good qualification and / or experience.

(b) possess a degree of a recognised University preferable in Social Science with Sociology, Psychology or Economics as principal subject,

(c) experience in Social Welfare Institution will be desirable :

Provided that preference will be given to candidate who in addition :—

(i) possess a Post-Graduate degree of Masters of Social Work or Diploma in Social Work or Social Service Administration preferably with specialisation in Criminology, Juvenile Delinquency and Correctional Administration or Specialisation in Family and Child Welfare of a recognised University or Institution of Social Work.

OR

(ii) have previous experience of working on the field of Social Welfare, preferably in the administration of the Children Act or Probation of Offenders Act or Prevention of Begging Act or Supersession or Immoral Traffic Women's and Girls Act, and other allied field of Social Welfare for a period of three years.

(d) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati.

3. A candidate appointed by direct selection will be kept on probation for a period of one year.

4. A selected candidate will be required to pass Departmental Examination and 'Examinations in Gujarati and Hindi according to the rules prescribed by Government.

5. A candidate appointed by direct selection who will be imparted training at Government cost shall be required to service Government for a period of three years and shall to execute Security and Surety bonds for Rs. 800 in the prescribed form.
